This forthcoming conference follows the success of the past nine AAVM held in Helsinki, Ottawa, Orlando, Prague, Tel Aviv, Washington DC, Berlin, Budapest and Rome. Veterinary use of antimicrobials has raised worries for the potential of resistance transfer from animals to humans. Antibiotic resistance is often caused by the misusage and/or overuse of antibiotics, as well as poor infection prevention and control. Research on new and alternative antimicrobial molecules, early detection of diseases, biosafety and control measures for infections in intensive farms will also be in the spotlight in the upcoming AAVM meeting as well.
